Airline Masterclass

Shuttleworth College
28th March 2007
9.00am - 15.30pm

Up to four volunteers are required to assist the YENW staff in running this event. The all day masterclass will introduce students to the concept of running a business. In this case the example of the airline industry is used. Students will set-up their own airline, choose job roles, decide routes, create corporate branding and sell their seats to a variety of travel agents. At the end of the day they will tell the rest of their year group about their company and experience during a two minute presentation. Volunteers are required to work with the students in groups, negotiate with them as hypothetical travel agents and even to sell them flight licences or planes themselves! The budget is £200 million so this will be a very big day!

Football Masterclass

On the first of May Shuttleworth College will follow their Airline Masterclass with the YENW Football Masterclass. During the day they will set-up their own football club, designing kits and then a stadium using CAD software and laptop computers. They will find sponsors and negotiate rates with them, whilst keeping track of club finances as weekly match results fluctuate through the season (day). At the end of the afternoon each group will deliver a presentation and tell their classmates about their finances, sponsors, stadium and more. Volunteers are required to assist with sponsor negotiations, help with teamwork, help calculate finances and for those more IT literate volunteers to use CAD software to design a stadium.

Primary Programme

The incredibly popular Young Enterprise Primary Programme will be spreading its wings at the Hapton CE Methodist Primary school on the 3rd May. With three year groups taking part the day will be very exciting for all involved and an absolute thrill for any volunteer who chooses to offer their time. Year 1 will be completing the Ourselves module (which focuses on individuals and the roles they play as employees, employers and members of the community), Year 3 will be completing Our Community module (which teaches children about the importance of local and wider communities and how money moves around), Year 4 will be completing the Our City module (in which they will learn about the different districts of a city environment and the town planning process) and finally Year 6 will be completing the Our World module (introducing this year group to global trade and industry). Volunteers will lead each class through their modules with the assistance of a classroom teacher, no experience of teaching is required just enthusiasm and attendance at a training session before the day. All modules are supported by games and workbooks and most importantly make learning fun.
